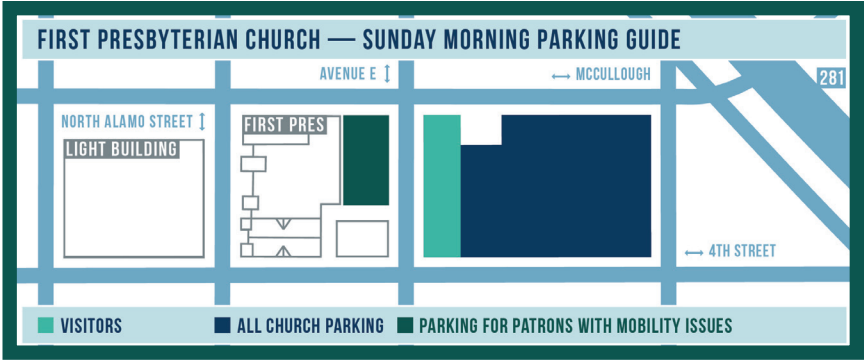
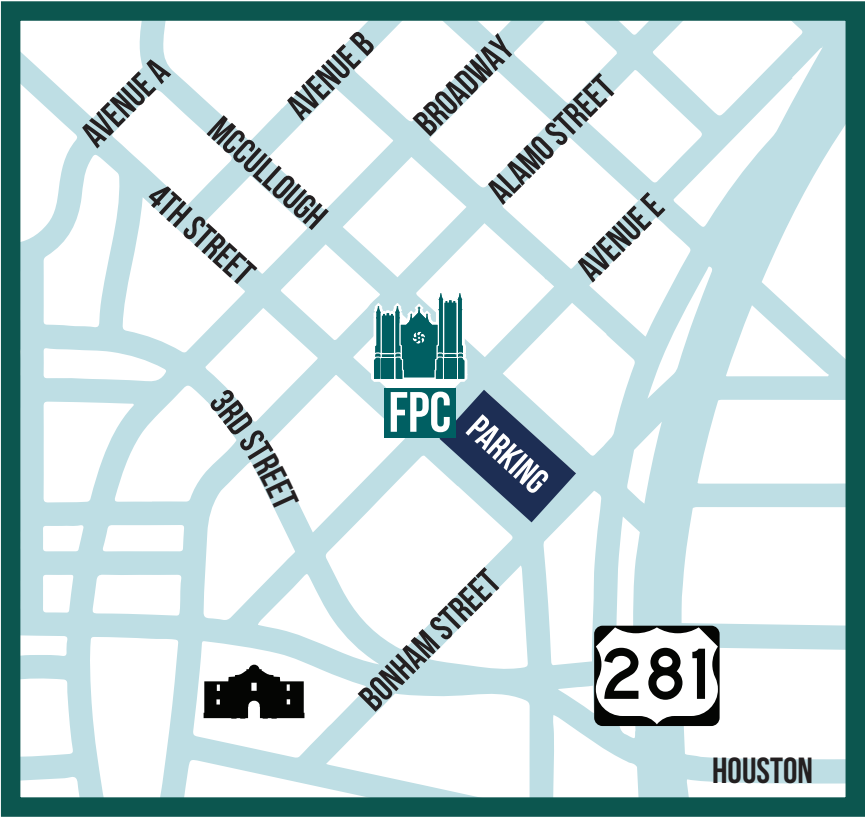

PARKING MAP



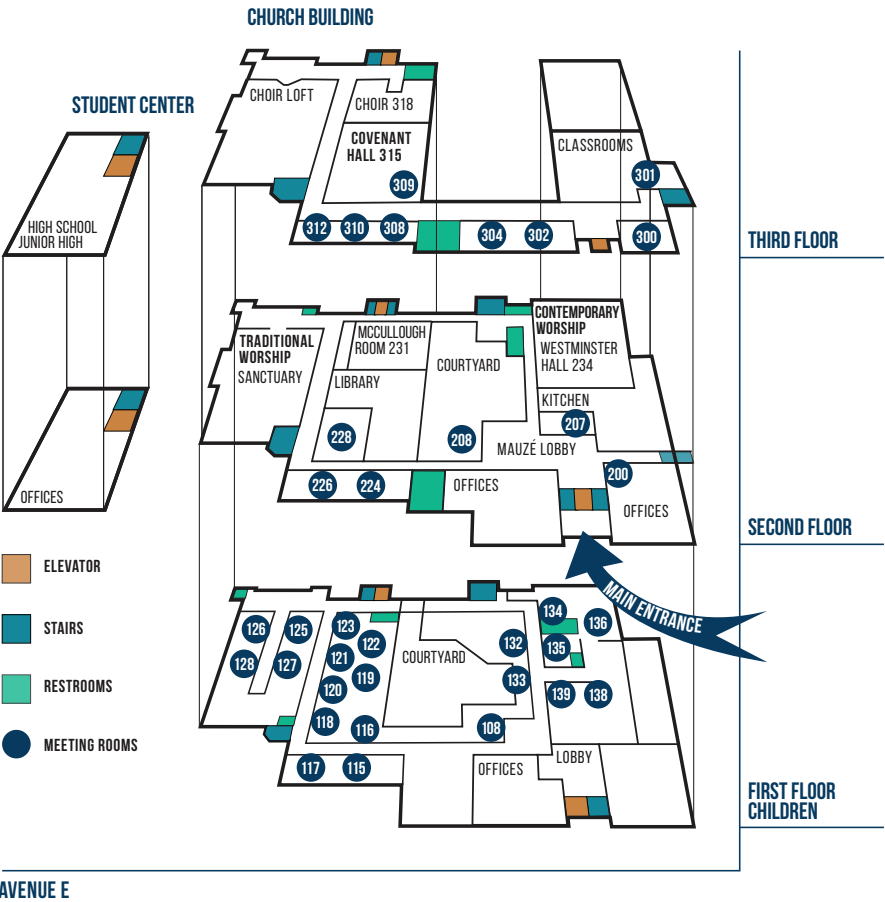
