FOSTER CARE/FAMILY IMPACT

- Increase in domestic abuse
- Financial strain in households
- Impact of social distancing - magnifying areas of breakdown in marriages/families
- Fewer Foster Families
- Increased domestic abuse and child abuse cases expected
- Children without access to school, extracurricular activities, etc

MENTAL, PHYSICAL, AND SPIRITUAL HEALTH IMPACT

- Increased depression, anxiety giving rise to the already large mental health crisis in our city
- Challenges to access physical health resources
- SA Christian Dental Clinic's volunteers to return to serving, as the Clinic is unable to provide service without them.

- Patients of the SA Dental Clinic with urgent needs – that their needs may be reduced until they are able to be seen at no cost, and for those who are unable to wait to obtain access to care.
- Increased impact toward substance abuse/addiction
- Overwhelming need for access to counseling
- Families who have no access to healthcare
- Pray that the Coronavirus would not affect marginalized communities in San Antonio.
- Need for discipling/mentoring to respond to crisis and uncertainty with hope
