- Healing and restoration in countries who have been devastated by recent natural disasters and/or political unrest. Pray for our ministry partners who are serving in these regions.
- More laborers to faithfully steward their gifts for the advancement of the gospel among the nations.
- Provision for vulnerable communities, especially those who do not have access to food.
